"सादा जीवन, उच्च विचार" पर सर सदैव चलते रहे।



Regionalism and Regional Politics in India

Abstract

In India regionalism is a heavy weight on the political system. Even prior to independence, regionalism was used as a tool by the imperialists to promote their policy of keeping India divided. Regionalism was deliberately encouraged by many with the result that the people of each region thought more in terms of their region rather than of India as a whole after independence efforts were made to make the people realise that they belonged to India as a whole. India is perhaps the most diverse nation in the world in terms of language, culture, religion and caste. These diversities for ages now are so deep-rooted in the Indian psyche that they have done more harm than good to the nation. However, when the struggle for Independence was on, there was a stroll sense of patriotism which kept the regional chauvinism under check and height and national consciousness. It gave people a new identity of being an India first and then anything else. This was mainly due to the efforts of Mahatma Gandhi who had successfully sowed the seeds of national identity in the minds of the otherwise fragmented masses. His contribution in this respect is even More laudable keeping in view the British rulers' policy of divide and rule which was pursued to ensure that India did not emerge as a formidable force. On one hand Gandhi was trying to unite the different groups while on the other, there was a rise in the number of groups who saw these divisions as a hindrance in their fight against British imperialism. Both these forces did further the cause of nationalism in their own way. However, after Independence, efforts for national unification became gradually weak and the emphasis once again shifted onto regionalism with a rise in the number of parties projecting themselves as champions of regional interest.

At the opening session of the national integration conference on 28 September 1961 Prime Minister Jawaharlal Nehru cautioned against 'evils' such as 'communalism, casteism, regionalism and linguism'. Fortyfive years later on 1 September 2005, while reviving the National Integration Council (NIC) inaugurated by then Prime Minister of India,



Dignity of Women is under Threat

Abstract

The reality of women's lives remains invisible to men and women alike and this invisibility persists at all levels beginning with the family to the nation. Although geographically men and women share the same space, they live in different worlds. The mere fact that "Women hold up half the sky"- does not appear to give them a position of dignity and equality. True, that over the years women have made great strides in many areas with notable progress in reducing some gender gaps. Yet, crime against women has been increasing at the rate of 20 to 25 per cent per annum in India. Women trafficking, rape, murder, honour killings, molestation, teasing, sexual abuse, abduction, prostitution, dowry related crimes, foeticide, infanticide, etc. are some of the crimes that are being inflicted on women. Of late crime against women have reached a horrendous proportions, How long will this inhuman act continue? Would the society take necessary steps to check crime against women?

Introduction

The very foundation of India as a nation is based on non-violence. However, it is indeed a matter of shame that Indian women are not only considered infra-human but have to face violence constantly. As a matter of fact, barring a few legally recognised crimes against women, such as dowry and sati, most of the atrocities against them are not counted as crimes even. Unfortunately, even women have recognised violence against them as fait accompli, statistically speaking, globally crime against women have been increasing. In India, crimes against women have been increasing at the rate of 20 to 25 per cent per annum. Of all the crimes taking place in the country, 7 per cent crimes are held against women. It is quite likely that the actual figure is quite higher because women hesitate from getting their complaints recorded in the police station and end up tolerating crimes against them meekly for the fear of social ostracism and public humiliation often; they are also made to reconcile.

Rape, molestation, teasing, sexual-misbehaviour, abduction, prostitution, dowry related crimes, foeticide, infanticide etc. are some of the crimes committed commonly against women. Of late, crime against women have undergone horrendous proportions, some of which are utterly in human like group rape in public places, in parks, in trains and in buses, throwing acid on their faces, violently extracting foetuses and throwing them in fire during the communal riots, committing the dead body to tandoor after murdering, parading naked the women panchas and sarpanchas. Indian Dystopia: Fear, Feat and Failure of Indian Muslims

Dystopia: A Bird's Eye-view:

The word 'Dystopia', which 'evokes disturbing images' (Claeys) and 'landscapes defined by ruin, death and destruction' (Claeys), is derived from two Greek words, dus and topos, meaning a diseased, bad, faulty, or unfavourable place. In common parlance as well as from both literary and historical viewpoints, the noun Dystopia functions (allegedly) as the opposite of 'utopia', the bad place versus what we imagine being the good place, the secular version of paradise. The adjective Dystopian implies fearful futures where chaos and ruin prevail (Claeys). In short, we can say that dystopian literature probably revolves round science and society that threaten to dominate and/or destroy humanity. Amongst the three types of dystopia political, environmental and technological mentioned in the book Dystopia: A Natural History (2017) by Gregory Claeys, it is the totalitarian political dystopia which is chiefly associated with the failure of utopian aspirations as well as received the greatest historical attention.

Let us consider this for the sake of argument that one's utopia may be another's dystopia as any society is mixture of both the elements. Like snake in the Garden of Eden, dystopian elements seem to lurk within utopia (Claeys). Even if utopia is understood as a virtuous society heading towards altruistic ends, one must not forget that utopia is built on repressive mechanism and remains, most of the time, an imperial power. 
Depiction of Globalization Culture in Kiran Desai's the Inheritance of Loss

The Inheritance of Loss is the second novel by Kiran Desai published in 2006. It won a number of awards, including the Man Booker Prize for that year and the National Book Critics Circle Fiction Award in 2007. It is a literary masterpiece in its description, characterization and depiction of human emotions. It is a story of the four individuals being turned into pawns due to political turmoil, Sai, Gyan, Biju and the Cook, Pannalal. The novel has two strands of narratives: the one dealing with the sociopolitical problems of the people of Kalimpong and the other depicting the painful andalienated existence of the Indian diaspora in New York. Through the character of Biju, sonof the Cook, Kiran Desai illustrates one of the major themes of the novel that is how globalization has brought in new immigrant culture. The novel analyses howin the post-colonial era, people from colonized countries face terrible hardships in Americawhich is a land of liberty. While discussing Desai's treatment of the theme of immigrationin the novel, Hirsh Sawhney points out: "Desai portrays migration as a universal, multifaceted experience, rescuing it from the clutches of myth and fetishism. Almost fiftyyears after the judge went to England, Biju, the Cook's son, leads a grueling existence asan illegal immigrant in New York."1

Kiran Desai depicts Biju's struggles and pathetic survival as an illegalimmigrant in New York "a city without horizon" and with "buildings going up likejungle creepers starved for light."²To fulfill the desire of his father, Biju, using fakedocuments and false recommendations, goes to America
