





## Third National Teachers Congress (NTC) Meet at MIT, Pune

Report by Dr. Ashwini Purude

The NTC was organized on the theme of 'Leapfrogging to Future Ready Higher Education' from 4<sup>th</sup> January, 2019 to 6<sup>th</sup> January, 2019. The Inaugural session was conducted at Gyandevi Saraswati Sabha Mandap, MIT World Peace University Campus, Pune began with the ringing of the Bell of Education, followed by welcoming and felicitation of the eminent guests convened at the event. Among the felicitated were the days' Chief Guest Dr. Bhushan Patwardhan, Vice – Chairman, UGC, Dr. Vijay Bhatkar, Prof. Dr. Vishwanath Karad, Dr. Sachchidanand Joshi, Shri. Anand Sudarshan, Dr. Chandrakant Pandav and Dr. Jay Gore.

The first speaker, Dr. Jay Gore, Global Convenor of NTC reminded the audience of the challenge standing in the way of teachers pertaining higher education. He said in the given future time scale, the teachers need to train the students to be able to discuss on problems. Shri. Nandkumar Nikam, Former President, Maharashtra State Principal's Federation expressed gratitude for creating a platform for providing an opportunity to interact with legendary minds. The Vice – Chancellor of MIT World Peace University, I. K. Bhat said that each teacher aspires for their students to be the best professionals, a good human and have positive attitude that will help them in improving quality of life to the world.

Founder Governor Shri Rahul Karad expressed that there is a certain need of the hour that there is a platform for an interdisciplinary discussion among teachers so that they can train their students to creatively solve the problems of societal issues. Dr. Anand Sudarshan, Founder and Director, Sylvant Teachers Advisors Pvt. Ltd. advised teachers to be in context and not teachers of content. Teachers should teach values and not formulas. He delivered a thought provoking speech on changes in education in the next 20+ years – a laying out of future landscape. Dr. Sachchidanand Joshi highlighted the role and glory of teachers in society and how the teacher is the first role model of the child. Dr. Sudhir Gavane, National Co-ordinator and Head of NTC talked about employability, entrepreneurship and chain reaction. Quality human capital creation creates quality jobs generating higher purchasing power thus giving rise to a higher level of demands in the market – boosting higher production for industry leading to more employment and investment ultimately creating prosperity. ■

The inauguration session conferred Jeevan Gaurav Puraskar to four renowned academicians:

1. Dr. P. C. Shejwalkar, SPPU President and Father of Management Education in Maharashtra,
2. Dr. Anil Sahastrabudhe, Chairman AICTE,
3. Dr. S. J. Chopra, Chancellor University of Petroleum and Energy Studies and



4. Dr. Parag Diwan, Vice – Chancellor, Great Lakes International University, Sri City, Andhra Pradesh.

The second day of the seminar also had a galaxy of scholars. Dr. Jay Gore, Reilly University Chair Professor of Engineering of Purdue University repeatedly insisted upon how the conduction of research could confer innovation in teaching the students. Prod. Dr. Anu Gokhale, Co-ordinator, Computer Systems Technology Programme, Illinois State University talked about engaged learning for future ready higher education. She added that students now need to prepare for jobs that don't exist yet. Prof. Dr. Gaurav Sant, Associate Professor in Civil and Environmental Engineering, University of California, pointed out on the current model of education that tends towards delivering information. He highlighted the importance of igniting questions in the minds of students.

Prof. Dr. Makarand Hastak, Professor and Head of the Division, Construction Engineering and Management, Purdue University USA, mentioned the three features of an economy: Digitalization, Decentralization and Electrification to make the country competitive on a global scale. Dr. Gajanan Sabnis, e Sachchidanand Joshi, Emeritus Professor and owner Sabnis Inc, Baltimore, USA underscored the need for teachers to be visionary individuals and classrooms should be full of discussions and interactive sessions. Dr. Ulthayasankar Sivarajah, Reader, Technology Management and Head of Logistics, University of Bradford, UK suggested alternate ways of teaching such as Research pedagogy and holographic lectures. Designing of curriculum should be as per the needs of students and job market.

On day 3 in the Valedictory session, Jeevan Gaurav Puraskar was conferred on three educationists:

1. Dr. Bala V. Balachandran, Padma Shri, J. L. Kellogg Distinguished Professor of Accounting and Information Management, Northwestern University, USA.
2. Dr. G. Vishwanathan, Founder and Chancellor, Vellore Institute of Technology and former MP, Lok Sabha.
3. Dr. Kota Harinarayana, Padma Shri, Distinguished Scientist, Former Vice- Chancellor, University of Hyderabad.

Award was also conferred on five best paper presentations. The session concluded by Presidential address of Dr. Raghunath Mashelkar.

The theme of NTC was globally relevant. The inauguration was followed by a series of discussions and deliberations over three days conference which was evenly distributed between Plenary sessions and parallel Paper Presentation sessions on each of the sub themes were presented by reputed teachers of Higher Education of various disciplines coming from across India. The session deliberations closed with interactive 'Teacher- to- Teacher' Connect Programme on Day 1 and Day 2 of the Conference with opportunities to network to each other.

The Journal 'IDEA' was unveiled which had selected Papers and Articles from Experts. The NTC was organized in collaboration with UNICEF (Social partner), NAAC (Quality partner), AICTE, AIU, AICP, Maharashtra State Principals Federation and UNESCO Chair for Human Rights, Democracy, Peace and Tolerance.

Among the speakers addressing the conference were 43% national and 57% were international with the maximum being from United States forming 35% of the total speakers. Asian and European speakers made up 8% and African and Australian speakers formed 3 % each. Prof. Mukhtar Shaikh, Dr. Arif Tamboli, Dr. Zoheb Hassan, Dr. Fakir Attar and Dr. Ashwini Purude attended and actively participated in the NTC.

## REPORT ON THE THIRD NATIONAL TEACHERS' CONGRESS HELD AT MIT

The third National Teachers' Congress (from 4 January -6 January 2019) held at MIT-WPU, Pune was a refreshing and enriching experience for us teachers. Distinguished personalities from the fields of education encompassing a broad spectrum of disciplines spoke on different and dynamic aspects of teaching and learning. Prof. Bhushan Patwardhan, Vice-Chairman UGC (University Grants Commission) was the chief guest. The very theme of the Congress i.e., **"Leapfrogging to Future"** provided the teachers a new horizon on future aspects of teaching. Prof. Jay Gore who was the Convener said that future is defined by time and space. You have to make yourself ready for what you are going to do after four years say. He emphasized on engaging in discussion with the learners (students), if you are not discussing don't upgrade your curriculum. Time and space concept caters to students too. He further said that how many of students of yours' will be thinking of them as future teachers. Hence we must leapfrog/jump high to achieve these goals. Mr. Nand Kumar Nigam highlighted the importance of platforms such as National Teachers' Congress (NTC). He said that teachers should interact and discuss among ourselves (T to T or Teachers to Teachers) discussion. We must take stock of each others' difficulties. The Vice-Chancellor of MIT-WPU, Prof. Bhat laid stress on bringing out the best potential from our students so that they can be best of professionals and human beings to guide the society. From "Collecting Dots to Connecting Dots"- this should be our goal. Rather than 'Best' we should focus on 'Next' he said. Some important things he highlighted were Critical thinking, creativity, innovation, digital literacy, media literacy, debating skills, flexibility and adaptability etc. Furthermore he said that there should also be social and cross cultural interactions amongst the students and leadership qualities to be inculcated in them. Global values to be encouraged rather than local values. Rahul Karad, the Executive President MIT-WPU said that Interdisciplinary Approach is very important. A mechanical engineering professor must talk to political science professor. Anand Sudarshan, Independent Director at NIIT who is also a member of Select Committees & Task Forces, Ministry of HRD dwelled on 'Becoming Future Ready' the teachers should aspire for this goal foremost. He highlighted the importance of teachers in shaping the students for tomorrow; they should be learners for life. Teachers should move on- they should now be 'Teachers of Context' rather than 'Teachers of Content'. From 'How' to 'Why' doing the things. He said, "Stop teaching formulae, start teaching values." Dr. Sachidanand Joshi, member secretary, Indira Gandhi National Center of Arts (IGNCA) and National President, Indian Board of Education urged for the need to have more informal interaction. There should be use of proper reference, resource and research material. Dr. Gajanand Sabnis who has authored more than 10 books such as 'Repair and Maintenance' and has published over 100 research papers in journals of United States and abroad said that 'Publish or Perish' phenomena shouldn't be applied in a haste. Dr. Shivraja quoted Abraham Lincoln that the best way to predict your future is to create it. He spoke about live holographic lectures and technology should be used for the betterment of the students. These were some of the important highlights of the Congress I got myself acquainted with.



## Third National Teachers Congress (NTC) Meet at MIT, Pune

Report by Mr. Mukhtar Shaikh

The NTC was organized on the theme of 'Leapfrogging to Future Ready Higher Education' from 4<sup>th</sup> January, 2019 to 6<sup>th</sup> January, 2019. The Inaugural session was conducted at Gyandevi Saraswati Sabha Mandap, MIT World Peace University Campus, Pune began with the ringing of the Bell of Education, followed by welcoming and felicitation of the eminent guests convened at the event. Among the felicitated were the days' Chief Guest Dr. Bhushan Patwardhan, Vice – Chairman, UGC, Dr. Vijay Bhatkar, Prof. Dr. Vishwanath Karad, Dr. Sachchidanand Joshi, Shri. Anand Sudarshan, Dr. Chandrakant Pandav and Dr. Jay Gore.

The first speaker, Dr. Jay Gore, Global Convenor of NTC reminded the audience of the challenge standing in the way of teachers pertaining higher education. He said in the given future time scale, the teachers need to train the students to be able to discuss on problems. Shri. Nandkumar Nikam, Former President, Maharashtra State Principal's Federation expressed gratitude for creating a platform for providing an opportunity to interact with legendary minds. The Vice – Chancellor of MIT World Peace University, I. K. Bhat said that each teacher aspires for their students to be the best professionals, a good human and have positive attitude that will help them in improving quality of life to the world.

Founder Governor Shri Rahul Karad expressed that there is a certain need of the hour that there is a platform for an interdisciplinary discussion among teachers so that they can train their students to creatively solve the problems of societal issues. Dr. Anand Sudarshan, Founder and Director, Sylvant Teachers Advisors Pvt. Ltd. advised teachers to be in context and not teachers of content. Teachers should teach values and not formulas. He delivered a thought provoking speech on changes in education in the next 20+ years – a laying out of future landscape. Dr. Sachchidanand Joshi highlighted the role and glory of teachers in society and how the teacher is the first role model of the child. Dr. Sudhir Gavane, National Co-ordinator and Head of NTC talked about employability, entrepreneurship and chain reaction. Quality human capital creation creates quality jobs generating higher purchasing power thus giving rise to a higher level of demands in the market – boosting higher production for industry leading to more employment and investment ultimately creating prosperity.

The inauguration session conferred Jeevan Gaurav Puraskar to four renowned academicians:

1. Dr. P. C. Shejwalkar, SPPU President and Father of Management Education in Maharashtra,
2. Dr. Anil Sahastrabudhe, Chairman AICTE,
3. Dr. S. J. Chopra, Chancellor University of Petroleum and Energy Studies and



4. Dr. Parag Diwan, Vice – Chancellor, Great Lakes International University, Sri City, Andhra Pradesh.

The second day of the seminar also had a galaxy of scholars. Dr. Jay Gore, Reilly University Chair Professor of Engineering of Perdue University repeatedly insisted upon how the conduction of research could confer innovation in teaching the students. Prof. Dr. Anu Gokhale, Co-ordinator, Computer Systems Technology Programme, Illinois State University talked about engaged learning for future ready higher education. She added that students now need to prepare for jobs that don't exist yet. Prof. Dr. Gaurav Sant, Associate Professor in Civil and Environmental Engineering, University of California, pointed out on the current model of education that tends towards delivering information. He highlighted the importance of igniting questions in the minds of students.

Dr. Gajanan Sabnis, e Sachchidanand Joshi, Emeritus Professor and owner Sabnis Inc, Baltimore, USA underscored the need for teachers to be visionary individuals and classrooms should be full of discussions and interactive sessions. Dr. Ulthayasankar Sivarajah, Reader, Technology Management and Head of Logistics, University of Bradford, UK suggested alternate ways of teaching such as Research pedagogy and holographic lectures. Designing of curriculum should be as per the needs of students and job market.

On day 3 in the Valedictory session, Jeevan Gaurav Puraskar was conferred on three educationists:

1. Dr. Bala V. Balachandran, Padma Shri, J. L. Kellogg Distinguished Professor of Accounting and Information Management, Northwestern University, USA.
2. Dr. G. Vishwanathan, Founder and Chancellor, Vellore Institute of Technology and former MP, Lok Sabha.
3. Dr. Kota Harinarayana, Padma Shri, Distinguished Scientist, Former Vice- Chancellor, University of Hyderabad.

Award was also conferred on five best paper presentations. The session concluded by Presidential address of Dr. Raghunath Mashelkar.

The theme of NTC was globally relevant. The inauguration was followed by a series of discussions and deliberations over three days conference which was evenly distributed between Plenary sessions and parallel Paper Presentation sessions on each of the sub themes were presented by reputed teachers of Higher Education of various disciplines coming from across India. The session deliberations closed with interactive 'Teacher- to- Teacher' Connect Programme on Day 1 and Day 2 of the Conference with opportunities to network to each other.

The Journal 'IDEA' was unveiled which had selected Papers and Articles from Experts. The NTC was organized in collaboration with UNICEF (Social partner), NAAC (Quality partner), AICTE, AIU, AICP, Maharashtra State Principals Federation and UNESCO Chair for Human Rights, Democracy, Peace and Tolerance.

Among the speakers addressing the conference were 43% national and 57% were international with the maximum being from United States forming 35% of the total speakers. Asian and European speakers made up 8% and African and Australian speakers formed 3 % each. Prof. Mukhtar Shaikh, Dr. Arif Tamboli, Dr. Zoheb Hassan, Dr. Fakir Attar and Dr. Ashwini Purude attended and actively participated in the NTC.

Two-Day National Seminar on  
**"Institutionalization of IQAC & New NAAC Guidelines"**  
organised by Shri Shahu Mandir Mahavidyalaya, Pune – 411 009  
on 18<sup>th</sup> & 19<sup>th</sup> January 2019

Recently NAAC have introduced Revised Accreditation Framework and implemented new framework across the nation. This change brought new guidelines to entire accreditation and assessment process. It made the entire process more vibrant and focused. It brought remarkable changes in entire teaching learning and administration of colleges. It has been observed that Colleges and institutions are somehow chaotic to understand the new guidelines of the RAF. Hence Shahu Mandir Mahavidyalaya organized this two day National Seminar to highlight on New NAAC guidelines and institutionalization of IQAC team in terms of achieving the smoothness and flexibility not only to understand the process but implement it in an appropriate manner to achieve expected excellence in all operations.

# SOLUTION TO EXTENDED TRANSPORTATION PROBLEM BASED ON COMMON SET OF WEIGHTS

**Abstract:** The main objective of transportation problem is the shipping of homogeneous goods from various origins to various destinations. In classical transportation problem, the distribution of goods is made by considering only one quantitative characteristic per shipment link. However, in real life, it is observed that the decision about the distribution of goods is based on several factors. In this paper, the transportation problem is extended by considering multiple incommensurate inputs and outputs for each shipment link, known as extended transportation problem (ETP). Common set of weights approach is proposed to compute the relative efficiency of each shipment link. The shipment plan with maximum efficiency is considered as optimal solution to ETP. A numerical example is discussed in order to validate the applicability of proposed approach.

**Keywords:** Data Envelopment Analysis (DEA); Decision Making Unit (DMU); Relative Efficiency; Extended Transportation Problem (ETP).

## INTRODUCTION

The transportation problem is a subclass of linear programming problem. It has the great importance in all type of production industries. The main objective of transportation problem is the shipping of homogeneous commodity from various origins to various destinations such that total cost of transportation will be minimum. The formulation of classical transportation problem is based on only cost or profit for each possible shipment link. But it is observed that in many real situations the shipment of goods is made by considering several kinds of variables such as cost, distance, shipment value, manpower, profit, mode of transportation, etc. These variables are classified as input and output variables and should be incorporated for each possible shipment link. The decision makers may have different aims to achieve for each possible shipment link, which may conflict to each other. In such situation, an optimal transportation plan is decided by taking into account the relative efficiency of each shipment link.

## REVIEW OF LITERATURE

The distribution of homogeneous production from several sources to numerous localities was originally mentioned as transportation problem by Hitchcock (1941). Data Envelopment Analysis (DEA) is a mathematical approach to compute relative efficiency of decision making units (DMUs). The comparative efficiency of a set of DMUs such as airlines, railways, banks, automobile manufacturers,
