The IQAC coordinator and Vice-Principal Mr. Iqbal Shaikh welcomed the honoured guests and participants highlighting on the need of such FDPs from the value-addition and accreditation point of view. The FDP Coordinator Dr. Shaikh Muhammad Zuber A.M. presented the FDP theme and introduced the chief guest and guests of honour. The FDP received tremendous response with the enrolment of 104 participants, many of whom were from other institutions.

#### Two-Day FDP on *Internet of Things* (17/01/2018 to 18/01/2018)

It was organized with an objective to have a thorough examination and in-depth description on the features of the platforms. The goal was to examine both commercial

and open source IoT platforms, as well as to map IoT use cases and applications to the platforms and highlight the factors that influence platform adoption.

Connected devices can exchange information and communicate with one other, which can then be processed to make decisions. This drive was also undertaken to give impetus to Honourable Prime Minister Narendrajii Modi's agenda of *Clean India, Healthy India* with an aim at sensitizing the staff, students and people

residing in the college area on maintaining a dust-free workstation, hygienic behaviour and promoting the message of cleanliness. All the Departments undertook various activities like dusting, cleaning, reviewing and weeding out of old records, digitization of records, disposal of old and obsolete items etc. Small sign-boards/plates and dustbins installed in the college were brought into notice and proper care and use of these dustbins was consolidated by encouraging staff and students in this *Massive Cleanliness Drive*.

### Cleanliness Pledge (02/08/2017)

The NSS Cell of Poona College administered the pledge to all members of Poona College family including staff, students and the authority. The pledge was recited ceremoniously and concluded with an announcement to assemble the next day to undertake conscientiously a *Massive Cleanliness Drive* in the college.

### *Swachha Bharat* Summer Internship (20/06/2018 to 29/06/2018)

This internship aimed at 100-hour experiential internship programme that required the candidate to visit a village and conduct activities of their choice to contribute to the cause of rural sanitation in India. The objective of this internship programme was to engage the youth across the country and develop their skill for sanitation-related work, amplify mass-awareness on cleanliness and cement the people's movement with the aspect of *Swachh Bharat Mission*. This was in line with the Prime Minister Narendrajii Modi's call on October 2, 2014 for each individual to devote 100 hours to *Swachhata* throughout the year. The NSS wing successfully completed the 10 Day residential camp under *Swachh Bharat Summer Internship* at its adopted village Kanhe (Tq. Maval, Dist. Pune), by carrying out several activities during the camp such as awareness campaigns, dustbin installation, cleaning of dumps, wall-paintings etc.

### Blood Donation Camp (01/03/2018)

In association with Ruby Hall Clinic, Pune, was organized a voluntary and unremunerative *Blood Donation Camp* in the college campus. The Medical staff of the Ruby Hall Clinic – surgeons and nurses – under the supervision of Medical Officer Dr. S. M. Bera collected nonstop seventy-five pouches in a short period of two hours. Mr. Rakesh Sajlani, Public Relation Officer, and Mr. Sunil Patil, personnel from Ruby Hall Clinic applauded the congregation of the college students standing in queue for blood donation.

### One Day Camp to enrol Eligible Citizens for the benefit of Several Government Schemes (28/01/2018)

The NSS cell actively participated in the *Mahayojna Shibir* at Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose High School, Yerwada conducted by Pune District Legal Service Authority, Shivaji Nagar, Pune. The NSS volunteers were assisting *Samaj Vikas Vibhag* looking after the diversely-disabled mob lined up for benefit, extended help to the pack waiting in line to apply for ration card, correction and renewal under the scheme *Ann-Dhanya Vitaran Vibhag*, helped the coterie under *Mahila Bal Vikas Vibhag*, worked with *Maharashtra State OBC Finance & Development Corporation Ltd.*, were at desk attending the populace, filling the application-forms on their behalf, distributing token numbers and directing the populace to particular room reserved for the scheme applied, were disciplining the densely packed crowd dashing the gate for AADHAR, Income Certificate and PAN Card, and some were educating each one waiting in line on which scheme they can avail or are eligible for, the documents required and the exact locations of rooms (spreading in two buildings each with three floors) reserved for particular scheme.

### Survey for Utilization of Government Schemes (25/01/2018)

The drive was executed in collaboration with the Pune District Legal Service Authority (PDLISA). The NSS Cell successfully conducted, in the major slum area of Pune city, an altruistic drive taking stock of families below poverty line who are indeed eligible for, but ignorant of, several Government Schemes in order to enrol them as beneficiaries.

### Tree Plantation Drive in Adopted Village (05/07/2017)

The NSS wing set out to bring Bopgaon village under a canopy of *Save Trees, Save Earth* with the cordial help and enthusiastic support from the members of Bopgaon Panchayat Board and the villagers. The objective was to launch awareness campaign warning the villagers of environment degradation and asking them to volunteer guardianship of the 100 seedlings planted in the village. Forty-five volunteers under the supervision of six staff-members planted 100 seedlings which include *Chinch, Aawala, Jaambhal* 20 plants each and *Mohogani, Moha, Spatodiya and Adulsa* 10 plants each. Shri. Ram Phadtare, Upsarpanch, Shri. Dyanoba Phadtare, Chairman, Kanifnath Temple Trust, Bopgaon, Shri. Tukaram Phadtare, Society Chairman, Shri. N. D. Shivarkar, Gramsevak, and the rest of the Bopgaon Grampanchayat Members were present on the occasion and partook avidly in the said programme.



## National/International Level Commemorative Days Celebration

### REPUBLIC DAY (26<sup>th</sup> January 2018)
