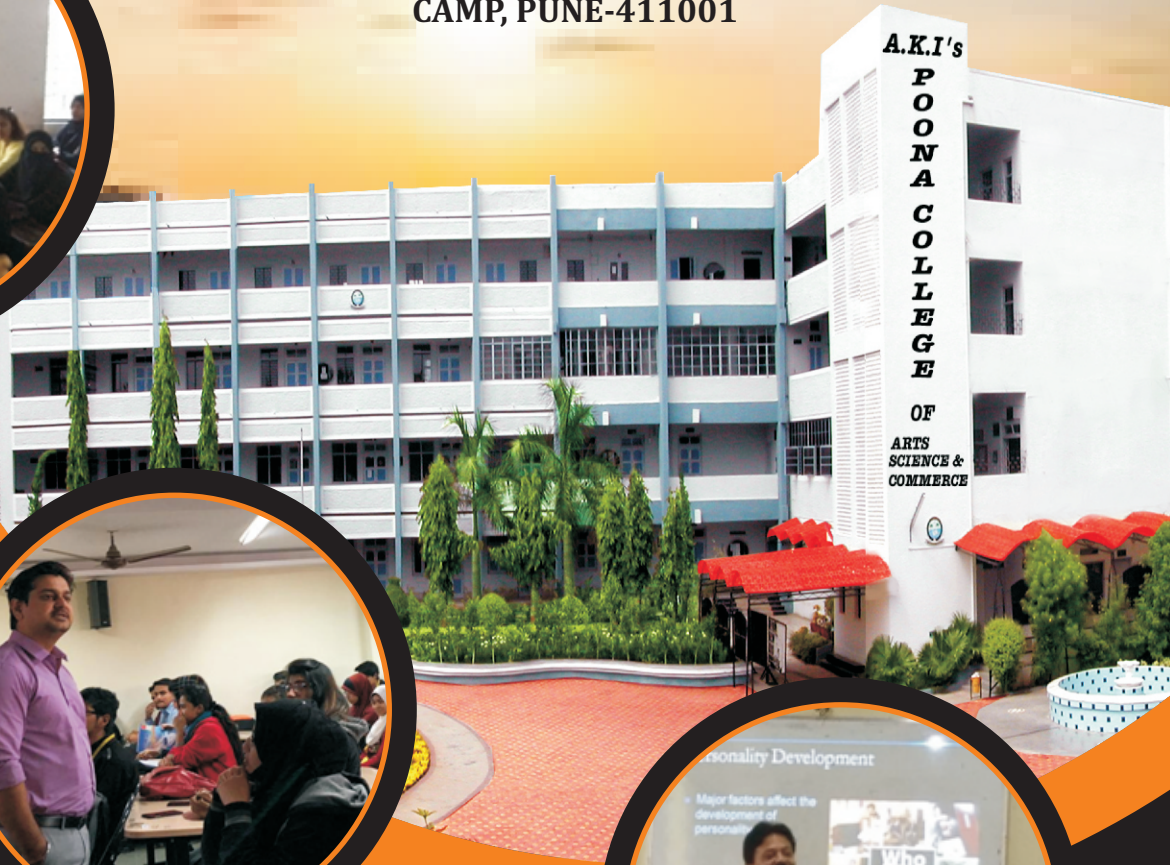

Guest lecture on “Perspectives for Emerging Business Opportunities”

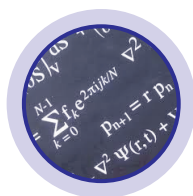

Guest Lecture on “Career opportunities in IT sector after B.Sc. Physics”

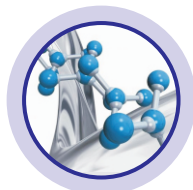

An Employability Training Program in Collaboration with "Rexona Confidence Academy"

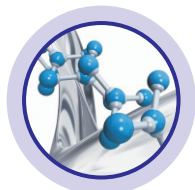
