		Screening of a feminist movie 'The Doll's House'	<ul> <li>This movie projected the concept of Feminism and how it implies the advocacy of women's rights on the grounds of being politically, socially and economically equal to men.</li> <li>'A Doll's House' was written at a time when society was not prepared to accept the liberation of women. The viewer's thus learnt how society was instrumental in assigning stereotypical roles to a woman leading to frustration and subsequent revolt.</li> <li>The main character of the movie Nora lived in a patriarchal society. She did not have any identity of her own .She worked hard to fulfil all the expectations of her husband and children at the cost of her own dreams. The movie concludes with Nora breaking away from the shackles of the stereotypical roles assigned to her and moves into a world where she reigns leading to the fulfilment of her dreams. The movie thus projected the theme of women's liberation.</li> <li>Through this screenplay, organizers succeeded in spreading the message of Gender Equality.</li> </ul>
