**Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)  
For Academic Exchange and Co-operation  
Between**

**Bhusawal Arts, Science and P.O. Nahata Commerce College, Bhusawal,** (here-in after referred as the **Bhusawal College**) and **Poona College of Arts, Science and Commerce, Camp Pune** (here-in after referred as the **Poona College**) desired to develop academic exchange and co-operation in education and research between the two institutes and have agreed to sign & enter into MoU as follows:

**1. Objectives:**

- a. To provide a common forum for exchange of ideas and views regarding designing and/or execution of curriculum/ Programmes and research activities in the following broad areas.
  - i. Humanities including:
    - a) English Language and Literature
    - b) Marathi Language and Literature
    - c) Hindi Language and Literature
  - ii. Social Sciences
  - iii. NSS, NCC, Sports, Extra Curricular Activities
- b. To use and share of libraries, laboratories, database, documentation and instrumental; and related infrastructure facilities of each other.
- c. To exchange of information and arrange joint seminars/workshops etc.

**2. Activities and Programmes**

The institutions based upon the principle of respect of each other's independence and of mutual benefit, will carry out the following activities:

- i. Exchange of Students
- ii. Exchange of Faculty and Research Students
- iii. Exchange of Publications and Information
- iv. Joint Research Activities



### **3. Formulation of Plan**

In order to carry out the above activities, detailed plans shall be formulated after consultation between the two colleges from time to time depending on the nature and need of specific activity, availability of funds and convenience of both the colleges. However, the basic principle shall be mutual co-operation and academic benefit of students and faculty of both the colleges.

### **4. Financial Terms and mode of payment if any:**

The requirement of funds for these activities/ programmes shall be worked out through mutual consent between the **Bhusawal College** and the **Poona College**.

The **Bhusawal College** and the **Poona College** shall not demand any monetary charges from each other for the use of technology and know-how developed for their own internal use for the purpose of teaching training, research and development.

### **5. Dissemination of data and information**

The **Bhusawal College** and the **Poona College** shall work out the modalities for dissemination of research data to any third party keeping in mind the mutual academic interest. However, both parties shall fulfill their obligation of disseminating the data to national databanks, as required by the concerned funding agencies.

### **6. Co-ordination committee**

A joint co-ordination committee for smooth and effective execution of activities and programmes under this MoU shall be formed by mutual consent.

### **7. Period of MoU**

This Memorandum of Understanding comes into effect from the date of its signing and will remain into force initially for three years. Its validity may be extended by mutual agreement between the two institutions.

### **8. Revision etc of MoU:**

This Memorandum of Understanding may be revised or terminated upon mutual consultation between the two institutions.


### **9. Non-exclusive Nature of this MoU:**

This MoU between the **Bhusawal College** and the **Poona College** is and shall be non-exclusive in its nature for both the parties and shall not come in the way of either partner from collaboration with the third party.
