



Dr. Manohar Igle, Ex Dean of MIT was the guest for the one-day workshop. He guided the students on








Figure 2Dr.Aftab Anwar Shaikh Delivering Welcome Speech




Figure 4 Keynote address by Chief Guest Dr.Parag Kalkar




