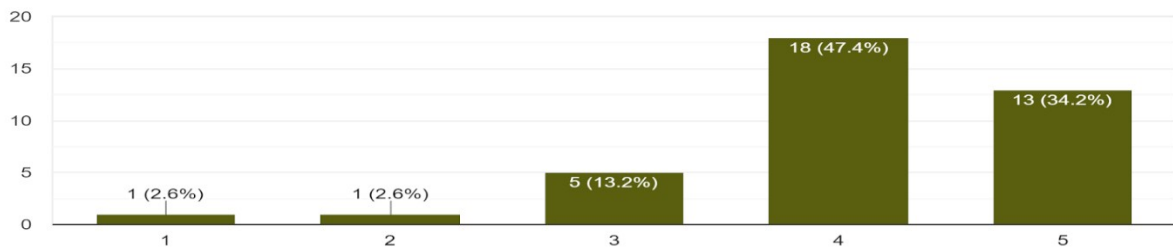
How relevant and helpful do you think it was for your project?

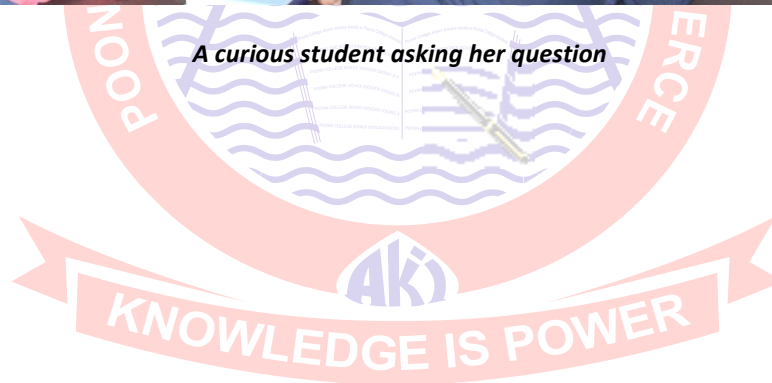

With this, Mr. Ismail Akbani ended his talk. He infused the attendees with motivation and inspiration and of course with endless wisdom.



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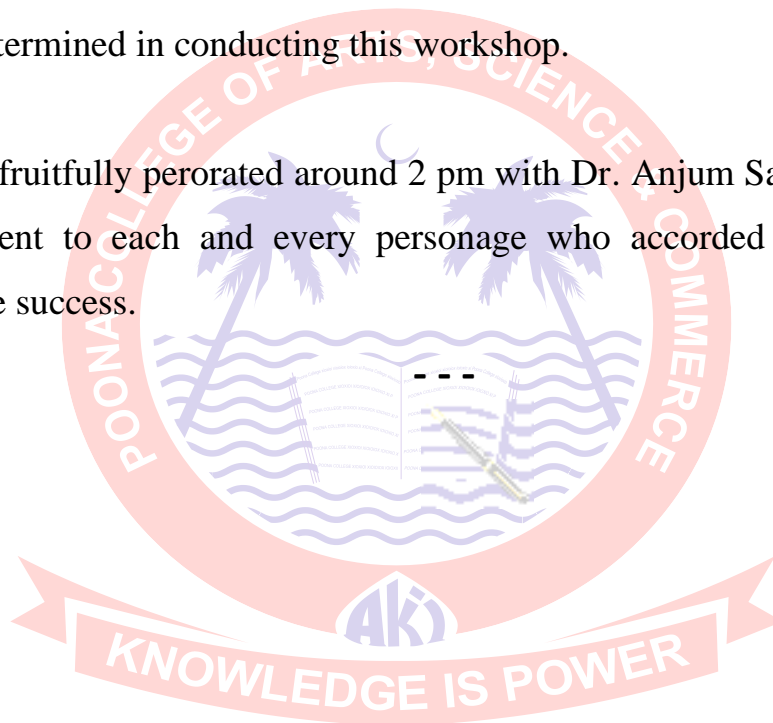

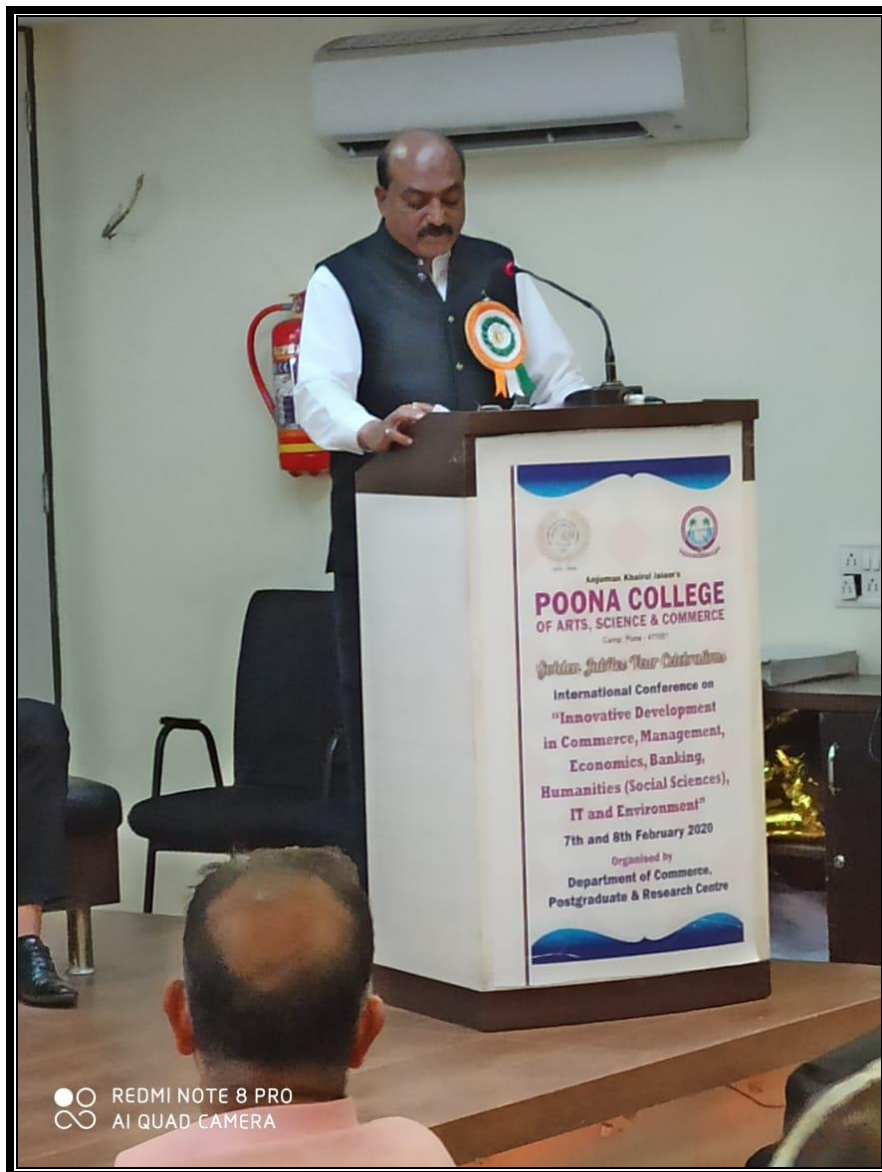


Figure 2Dr.Aftab Anwar Shaikh Delivering Welcome Speech
