DISATER MANAGEMENT TRAINING WORKSHOP

25th & 26th February 2017

A training workshop on "Disaster Management" was jointly organized by Board of Students' Welfare, Savitribai Phule Pune University and AKI's Poona College of Arts, Science and Commerce, Camp, Pune on the 25th and 26th of February, 2017 at the Conference Hall and Campus. This was conducted to spread awareness among the young students about disasters that occur all of a sudden, mitigation methods and also how to prevent them.

The program was inaugurated on the 25th at the hands of Dr. Aftab Anwar Shaikh, Vice Principal, (Commerce), AKI's Poona College of Arts, Science and Commerce, after Tilaawat-e-Quran by Mr. Navid Sayyad, student of M.A (English). In the first session, Dr. M.R.G. Sayyad, Head, Dept. of Geology, gave a detail account on the various disasters, their types and effects on human life and property through a power point presentation.

This was followed by a lecture cum demonstration on Emergency Ambulance Services provided by "108" and first aid given till these services arrive. Students were taught how to take care of accident cases, stoke patients, etc. and provide first aid so as to facilitate their movement to the hospital by the emergency services. After a lunch break in the second session Dr. Vanita Lombar, Resident Medical Officer, Sassoon Hospital, Pune, spoke in detail on various first aid measures to be taken after a disaster. She too gave demonstrations on how to make the patient comfortable till emergency services arrive.



This was followed by a film show on "Disaster Management" by Dr. Sajid Hundekari, Dept. of Geology. The programme was compered by Dr. Bhavana Deshpande. It ended with vote of thanks by Dr. Baba Shaikh.

On 26th February, the second day of the workshop, Mr. Mayuresh Jadhav, an N.S.S. Volunteer, showed ways of evacuation, escaping fires, rescuing people in floods, etc. After this, Mr. Sameer Shaikh, Station Officer, Fire Brigade, Pune, explained types of fires, their causes, ways of controlling them, common mistakes and how to avoid them through power point presentation. Later on, along with his fire fighting team, a demonstration on the use of different fire extinguishers was given. Students learnt handling and actual use of these extinguishers. The fire brigade machine was operated to show how it is used to put off fires. This was followed by a lunch break. In the post lunch session, another film show was arranged by Dr. Baba Shaikh on "Mitigation Methods". After this, an interactive group discussion was conducted for students where they cleared their doubts, and shared experiences.

The valedictory function marked the end of the workshop where students were given certificate of participation. Some spoke on what they learnt in the two days. Mr. Arbaaz Shaikh, a student from Earn and Learn Scheme, Mr. Mustafa Shaikh, an NSS Volunteer, Mr. B. Vimalnath, an NCC cadet, miss Kavita Sakhre, SY BSC student, Mr. Prateek Pandey, NCC cadet spoke enthusiastically with gratitude on how the workshop had inculcated awareness on disasters and ignited feelings of service to mankind. The programme was compered by Dr. Aafreen A. Ahmed.

The workshop was a great success thanks to the guidance and support of Dr. Rafique Sarkhawas, Principal, AKI's Poona College of Arts, Science and Commerce, Mr. Mohammad Shakir Shaikh, Students' Welfare Officer, members of Board of Students' Welfare: Dr. Bhavana Deshpande, Dr. Baba Shaikh, Dr. Aafreen A. Ahmed, Mr. Mukhtar Shaikh and of course the interactive gathering of students.

DETAILED REPORT

In compliance with the initiative taken by the Government of Maharashtra State to plant 2 Crore Trees in a day, the Poona College of Arts, Science and Commerce situated at the heart of Pune city organized *Tree Plantation Drive*' by planting 20 assorted seedlings in its premises by the hands of the Principal of the college Dr. M. Rafique Sarkhawas in the presence of the Registrar, Vice Principals of Arts, Commerce and Science faculty. The teachers, students and supporting crew consisting of NSS volunteers, NCC cadets and non-teaching staff were also present during the programme. The drive was funded by the College Management who pledged to bear the cost of yearlong nurturing of the trees planted.

A six-member Committee was formed by the Principal of the college on 20th of June 2016 which surveyed the whole campus, identified the suitable site and supervised the work of NSS Volunteers, NCC Cadets and supporting staff digging pits for tree-plantation. Later on, the Committee visited a nursery and, in consultation with the Registrar Mr. Salim Shaikh, bought seedlings, soil and fertilizer in the evening on 30th of June 2016. The details are annexed (annexure 2) with this report.

On 1st of July 2016 at 08:30 O' Clock in the morning, the college campus was brimming with the enthusiasm of the congregated staff and students for the Tree Plantation Programme. The programme commenced with the Recitation of Verses from the Holy Quran by Mr. Javed Akhtar, a faculty from the Department of Urdu, Persian and Arabic. Dr. M. Rafique Sarkhawas greeted the standing audience in the Open Auditorium of the college and stressed the importance of tree plantation to save the environment by protecting and preserving ecological balance. The onus of guarding the plants was shouldered on NSS volunteers and NCC Cadets who will take care of plants under the supervision of the Committee. He announced a healthy competition between NSS volunteers and NCC cadets which will evaluate them on the basis of the care they will take of plants. A surprise-reward will be awaiting the Best Guardian Group.

Dr. Shakir Shaikh compered the session and Dr. Sajid Hundekar proposed vote of thanks. The programme came to close after successful tree plantation under the able guidance of Dr. Rafique Shaikh, an Assistant Professor from the Department of Botany.

DESCRIPTIVE REPORT ON GLOBAL POLLUTION AND TRAFFIC RULES AWARENESS PROGRAMME








