**27<sup>th</sup> February, 2019:** A special workshop on Conventional Energy was jointl y organized by Savitribai Phule Pune University and the Board of Students' Develop ment of AKI's Poona College of Arts, Science and Commerce, Pune on 27th February , 2019. Eminent personalities in the relevant fields delivered lectures on the dif ferent aspects of Conventional Energy.

Principal Dr. Aftab Anwar Shaikh inaugurated the workshop by elaborating on its the me and relevance to students. The first speaker, Prof. Dattatray Late, a renowned scien tist from NCL, Pune, presented the 'Classification of energy sources and types' thro ugh a very effective Power Point presentation. He also gave an insight into the latest d evelopments in the field of Nanosciences.

Dr. Sambhaji Warule from Wadia College spoke on the need of '**Conservation of ene rgy**'. He suggested different ways to conserve energy and also tried to instill the value in students.

Dr. Kingsguk Roy, another budding scientist from IISER, Pune, presented his views o n **'Developments in the fields of renewable energy'**. His message was to reduce the use of fossil fuels and try to harness other renewable resources.

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### **REPORT: Disaster Management Training Workshop**

#### Date: 30/01/2019, 31/01/2019 & 04/02/2019

Time: 9.00am to 5.00pm

**Objective of the workshop:** To impart knowledge on renewable sources of energy and spread awareness on sustainable use of energy sources.

**31**<sup>st</sup> **January, 2019:** Savitribai Phule Pune University and the Board of Students' Development of AKI's Poona College of Arts, Science & Commerce, Pune, organized a two days Training Workshop on Disaster Management on January 30<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup>, 2019. Disaster management is the need of the hour, especially in the light of the recent floods, landslides and stampedes, etc. in recent years across the country. Thus, in order to spread awareness, this workshop was organized.

On the first day, Principal Dr. Aftab Anwar Shaikh inaugurated the workshop and motivated students to follow the two days training earnestly. He spoke on the importance of organizing the workshop for young students. The first speaker Dr. Rakshanda Sayyed delivered a presentation on **Instant First Aid** after a disaster. She explained through examples, the different medical emergencies that arise after a disaster. She showed simple ways to handle such situations.

The team from **108 Ambulance Services** elaborated on their activities. Dr. Asif Ahmad gave details on how this service provides immediate help to people all over the country and how to contact them in case of an emergency. His team mate, Mr. Rakesh Soddhe showed the interiors of ambulances used by 108 Services and the equipment they possess to save lives of patients.

Further in the day, after lunch, Dr. Sajid Hundekar showed a movie on Disaster Management. With this, he gave information on man-made and natural disasters, and how they affect life on earth. He showed what kind of losses we have to bear after a disaster strikes. There is loss of life and property too. We need to act wisely before and after disasters, he said.

On 31<sup>st</sup> January, Mr. Dandekar shared his experiences in this field. He spoke on the need of spreading awareness about disasters among youngsters, family and friends. He asked students to be vigilant, cautious, brave and sensitive to people and situations around.

The workshop concluded on 4<sup>th</sup> February, where Mr. Ananta Babulkar, Commandant 5 Battalion, NDRF, Pune spoke on reduction in disasters and handle them efficiently. He gave demonstration on artificial resuscitation, handling a bleed, snake bite, emergency exit during a disaster, etc.

Thus, this workshop passed on the golden rule: "for successful disaster management at all levels is to increase awareness, develop action plans and practice them".

The workshop was a success under the guidance of Principal Dr. Aftab Anwar Shaikh, Vice Principals Prof. Moinuddin Khan and Prof. Iqbal Shaikh, Students' Development Officer Dr. Baba Shaikh, and members of the committee. Mrs Iram Khan and Dr. Aafreen A. Ahmed compered the program for the two days. Students were given Certificates for attending the workshop.



# DESCRIPTIVE REPORT ON WALL PAINTING & BRUSH FOR BRAIN








Figure 2 Dr. Mujeeb Shaikh educating the NSS volunteers about AIDS- Symptoms, causes, Remedies






Figure 3 NSS volunteers Ms. Pratiksha more, Ms. Shweta Kharat and others during survey in Bhavani Peth, Pune. 16/12/2018








Figure 1- Program officer Poona College Mrs. Swaleha Mulla with Jal-tadnya (water expert) Dr. Rajendranath Sih (At center) and Dr. Shivaji Pacharne NSS District Coordinator SPPU at the workshop on 16-12-2018







These women, who are poor mothers, widows and orphan girls, will have an opportunity to use their skills to rise out of poverty and work towards a promising future for themselves and their families.



On 23 January 2019 at 12 noon an agitated group of F.Y.B.Sc students barged in the Principal's office. The students shared their concern for their F.Y.B.Sc classmate Ms. Fiza Shaikh who was going through a very difficult phase of life. Her father was hospitalized due to acute liver disease. Her mother took up a job as domestic help to support the family but still she could not arrange for his treatment. The Principal heard the ordeal of Fiza Shaikh and immediately called the teacher and student volunteers of Muskaan: The Healing Smile and explained FizaShaikh's case. Immediately the Muskaan volunteers got into action and drafted an appeal for donation. This appeal was circulated on the same day....



People who do not need a set of clothes or other useful items can deposit them in the donation boxes which are located near the Wall of kindness, these clothes are then mounted on the pegs of the wall of kindness and the needy can take whatever they want, without being questioned. The motto behind the wall of kindness is take what you need and leave what you don't. This wall just turns out to be a give and take between the needy ones and the ones who want to contribute to help the needy ones. With the regular site of dirty walls that are filled with spit stains and other posters, this wall stands an exception as it is beautifully painted by the youngsters who are devoted to the cause of humanity and are playing a major role in making Pune city a sensitive city that understands the needs of its deprived citizens.


