Report: River Cleanliness & No To Plastic Drive

2nd October, 2019: On the occasion of Golden Jubilee of NSS Unit of SPPU and to commemorate the 150th Gandhi Jayanti, a Cleanliness Drive under Swach Bharat Abhiyan was organized in Pune and Pimpri-Chinchwad areas. All the NSS Units of various colleges in these areas were given specific areas to carry out awareness drive by cleaning rivers - Mula-Mutha and Pavana.

The NSS Unit of Y & M AKI's Poona College of Arts, Science & Commerce, Pune, was allotted the area below Sangam Bridge, along Mula Mutha River, Shivajinagar. This activity was conducted alongwith AISSMS College of Engineering. Students gathered by 7am with all necessary equipment for river cleaning and protective gear such as gloves and masks.

After forming groups, students began the tedious work of collecting garbage along the riverside as well as the shallow waters of the river. They mostly found articles made of plastic such as bottles, cups, bags, etc. mixed with garlands and loose flowers that were dumped by the people during rituals carried out at the cremation ground as well as travelers passing the Sangam bridge. All the collection was properly disposed in the bins provided by the Municipal Corporation.

The second important activity was the Oath taking at Shaniwarwada, Pune. NSS student volunteers from Pune city gathered at the open ground near the historic Shaniwarwada to participate in the Oath taking ceremony. A pledge to make the city "Plastic Free" was taken by all the students, NSS Program Officers, Area Coordinators, District co-ordinator under the aegis of SPPU. This marked the end of the Campaign organized by NSS.

Commerce organized a one day Blood Donation Camp in the college campus in association

with Pimpri Chinchwad Blood Bank, Pimpri, Pune on Friday, the 4th of October, 2019.

Pimpri Chinchwad Blood Bank is an FDA licensed blood bank that works in association

with an NGO "Real Life Real People" to cater to the needs of society in regards with whole

blood and blood components. They work for nearly 150 hospitals in Pune, Pimpri and

Chinchwad.

The camp was inaugurated at the hands of Incharge Principal, Mr. Moinuddin Khan. He

inspected the facilities provided for the camp, talked to students and encouraged them. After

an initial checkup for weight, blood pressure and haemoglobin by the staff of the Blood

Bank, eligible candidates donated blood. They were taken care of by the staff and also given

refreshments after donation. The organizers handed Certificates to donors along with

coupons valid for life time to receive blood in case an emergency arises. They also

suggested measures to improve Hb count in girls.

38 courageous donors that included members from the teaching staff, non teaching staff and

students of the college donated blood. This was their greatest contribution to mankind! In

all 110 students attended the camp. This camp was conducted under the able guidance of

Incharge Principal Mr. Moinuddin Khan and Vice Principal (Science) Mr. Iqbal Shaikh The

program was a great success due to efforts from NSS volunteers, the donors, NSS Program

Officers Dr. Aafreen A. Ahmed and Mr. Akbar Sayyed and members of NSS.

REPORT: CELEBRATION OF NATIONAL YOUTH DAY

13th January, 2020: To mark the birth anniversary of Swami Vivekananda and honour the spiritual leader, the Indian Government has declared January 12 as National Youth Day. Report: Awareness Programme on Organ Donation

10th December, 2019: Organ and tissue donation is more important than many of us realize - for society and for the individuals it directly affects. Each day, more than 21 people die waiting for a transplant. The need for organ donors is growing, whereas, the organ donation rates in India is very poor around 0.3/million, as compared to Western countries where it is high as 36/million.

There is a dire need to spread awareness about organ donation and help our community, our country in progress. Keeping this mind, the NSS Unit of Y & M AKI's Poona College of Arts, Science and Commerce, Pune, arranged for a talk by Mr. Pankaj Pipada, member of ReBirth Foundation, Pune that is actively involved in creating an impact in spreading awareness and coordinating between donors and recipients, making the process easier.

Mr. Pankaj brought forth the importance of organ or tissue donation either after death or when the donor is alive. He motivated students to go for the noble cause so that a day arrives when no-one in India loses life because of unavailability of organs. He said- "By registering as an organ donor, one has the chance to save and improve the lives of upto 75 people"! He answered queries regarding safety and complications involved in this process.

Students pledged to "Give the gift of life: become an organ donor".

135 student volunteers attended this awareness program and promised to spread the message further to family, friends and the community. This program was a success under the guidance of Principal Dr. Aftab Anwar Shaikh, Vice Principals and efforts of NSS Program Officer Mr. Akbar Sayyed.

Report: Biggest Sleepout at Yerawada, Pune.

7th **December, 2019:** 1.8 million people live homeless in India, 74 families lack access to housing. This December 7th, a sleep out event was organized in solidarity and support of those experiencing homelessness and displacement. The initiative under the Centre for Youth Development and Activities (CYDA), at Ambedkar College Grounds in Yerawada was attended by representatives of several academic institutions, non-government organizations (NGOs) and social organizations working for the homeless.

The coordinator of this event, Dr. Gulab Pathan, Associate Professor at Y & M AKI's Poona College of Arts, Science & Commerce, Pune, briefed the gathering on the theme and objective of the event. He said that according to estimates, there were close to millions of homeless people in the country, including women, children and old people. Their plight is often ignored and they are shunned by the society. Their rights cannot be neglected and they deserved equal dignity and respect like any other citizen of the country.

This was a global campaign where people came out together for the cause of the less-privileged. Students experienced the feeling of spending a night in the open public space that the homeless face throughout their lives, the difficulties they face. They were proud to be a part of the global fight against homelessness and raising awareness on the issue in Pune.

06 volunteers spent the night on the open grounds in the chill of the night under the supervision of NSS Program Officer Mr. Akbar Sayyed. Principal Dr. Aftab Anwar Shaikh was present to encourage the students and interact with the participants.

Report: Survey of School Dropouts

11th & 12th September, 2019: Leaving school and studies at a very young age is a common phenomenon in India and many Asian and African countries. The reason mostly being poverty. Dropping out of school has serious consequences for students and their families. Students who decide to drop out of school face social stigma, fewer job opportunities, lower salaries, and higher probability of involvement with the criminal justice system.

The NSS Unit of Y & M AKI's Poona College of Arts, Science and Commerce, Pune conducted a survey of school dropouts during September, 2019. The neighbouring areas of college were chosen for the activity. Students moved in different areas forming groups of four. They talked to the families in detail about the number of members, income source of parents, number of children in each home, the numbers enrolled in school, the number of dropouts, etc. To their surprise, volunteers found that in almost every house one child was at home. The reason was that they were either helping parents in earning for the family or staying back to care for the younger siblings while parents were at work. Other major reasons were: lack of interest in studies, poverty and migration. Some other causes identified were: age of pupils, poor academic performance, employment, teacher pupil relationships, peer pressure and other school related factors such as no provision of lunch and poor structures.

Volunteers were saddened at the plight of the youngsters in the slums. 17 students participated in this activity. They counseled parents and the school dropouts to return to studies and suggested the various Government schemes that could help them achieve this easily.

The NGO lends a helping hand to keep our environment clean by organizing and executing training programmes in schools, colleges, corporate sectors, etc., to propagate the need of waste management and also provide hands on training in solid waste management.

Report: Maharashtra Anti - Tobacco Mass Pledge

11th July, 2019: Each year around 13.5 lakh people die due to tobacco related diseases and 26.7 crore people consume tobacco in India, of which, one-third or more die an early death. The main concern is that everyday around 5500 children start consuming tobacco in some form, whereas only 3% are able to quit. Taking serious note of this grave scenario, 'Pledge for Life – Tobacco Free Youth' campaign has been launched by the Government of Maharashtra. On the 11th of July this year, Maharashtra Anti-Tobacco Mass Pledge was planned and executed in colleges all over Maharshtra. 

23rd, September, 2019: The NSS Unit of Y & M AKI's Poona College of Arts, Science & Commerce, took a noble initiative by arranging a visit to Mauli Seva Pratishthan, Ahmednagar, that is looking after 300 homeless women and their 29 children. Managed by a doctor couple, this home takes lifelong care, treatment and rehabilitation of wandering, mentally and physically ill destitute women found on roads. Students interacted with them to find out more about their lives and how this charitable home is spreading joy in their lives. The doctor couple -The Dhamanes, treat the critically ill, feed them and work selflessly to improve the lives of these unfortunate women and their children. The visit was inspiring for students, instilling in them the values of empathy for the less privileged people of our society, hoping to raise them to become honest and respectable citizens of society. Students donated funds to the home before leaving to their next destination.

After this, students moved ahead to Hiwre Bazar and Ra leganSiddhi, the two model villages that have overcome drought and subsequent migration problems of its villagers. Both are noted for their water conservation programs, irrigation systems that have helped them fight the drought and drinking water problems. ^{Under} the guidance of Mr. Anna Hazare and <u>Popatrao Baguji Pawar</u>, the villages have secured bank loans for farmers and started <u>rainwater harvesting</u>, water conservation and management programs, which involved building 52 earthen bunds, percolation tanks, 32 stone bunds and nine check dams.

Students were amazed at the greatly improved socio-economic conditions in the villages and proud to have visited the village declared an "Ideal Village" by the <u>Government of Maharashtra</u>. They were excited to see the clever use of renewable sources of energy such as <u>solar power</u>, <u>biogas</u> and <u>windmill</u>.

50 students under the supervision of NSS PO Mr. Akbar Sayyed, visited these places. They found that the villages have water year round, have a grain bank, a milk bank, and a school. There is no longer any poverty......All this achieved with sheer determination by two simpletons who had the desire to serve the society selflessly. This was a very important lesson that the young minds learnt!



Date: 31/05/2020

Objective: To raise awareness on the harmful and deadly effects of tobacco use and second-hand smoke exposure, especially Oral Cancer and to discourage the use of tobacco in any form.

31st May, 2020: To draw global attention to the tobacco epidemic and the preventable death and diseases it causes, the Member States of the WHO created World No Tobacco Day in 1987. 31st May each year since then, has been celebrated to spread awareness on the widespread prevalence of tobacco and its negative effects on health, which currently lead to more than 8 million deaths each year worldwide, including the non smokers!

The NSS Unit in collaboration with IQAC and Department of Commerce, PG and Research Centre of Y & M AKI's Poona College of Arts, Science and Commerce, celebrated this day via the digital platform ZOOM, a step taken in the wake of the COVID-19 pandemic on 31st May, 2020.





SPECIAL WINTER CAMP

Special Camping forms an integral part of National Service Scheme. It has special appeal to the youth as it provides unique opportunities to the students for group living, collective experience sharing and constant interaction with community.

The NSS Unit of Y &M AKI's Poona College of Arts, Science & Commerce, Pune has adopted the Village at Kanhe, Maval district since 2018 to work during Special Winter Camp. This year, a team of 100 NSS student volunteers stayed at the village and worked at different levels for the betterment of the villagers.

REPORT: Poona College Helps Fight COVID - 19

Date: 15 April to 24 May, 2020

Objective: To cater to the needs of the needy affected by lockdown during the COVID – 19 pandemic

15 April to 24 May, 2020: March 2020 brought with it the greatest shock of the year! A normal flu turned out to be a deadly infectious disease called COVID – 19, caused by a new strain of coronavirus. This fast spreading virus lead to a pandemic bringing in a lockdown for days together. People were confined to their houses, scared and worried for health finance and their future. Labourers andtheir families were affected the most. After losing their jobs, and unable to travel back to their hometowns in other states, they were devastated!







THREE DAY FIRST AID TRAINING CAMP

Indian Red Cross Society, Pune organised three day first aid training camp They invited teams from colleges to learn First Aid Facility required in critical situation to save people from health danger. This is three day extensive program comprises basic and advanced training related with First Aid Facility. First aid is the first and immediate assistance given suffering from either minor to any person serious illness or injury with care provided to preserve life, prevent the condition from worsening, or to promote recovery. It includes initial intervention in a serious condition prior to professional medical help being available, such as performing cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) while waiting for an ambulance, as well as the complete treatment of minor conditions, such as applying a plaster to a cut. First aid is generally performed by someone with basic medical training.

Mr. Kulkarni, Secretary, Indian Red Cross Society, Pune Branch inaugurated this program. Many experts from medical field trained the volunteer students from different colleges. Mr. Hashim Ansari and Ms. Soleha attended this three day program from our college. Principal Dr. Aftab Anwar Shaikh inspired participant students at this occasion. 



Mehndi designing course includes various forms of mehndi application, theoretical and practical details of the art, as well as assignments and projects.




This course in Mehandi designing provides flexibility of learning the art. This primarily means that the duration of the course ranges from a few weeks to three months.


