REPORT ON

"ROLE PLAY ACTIVITY ON ACTIVE LISTENING SKILLS" FOR FY BBA STUDENTS

A Role Play activity on "Active Listening Skills" under Business Communication Skills for FY BBA students was conducted on 23rd September 2017 in M4 classroom between 9:10 to 10:00 am.

Active listening is a communication technique that is used in counseling, training, and conflict resolution. It requires that the listener fully concentrate, understand, respond and then remember what is being said.

Active listening involves listening with all senses. As well as giving full attention to the speaker, it is important that the 'active listener' is also 'seen' to be listening - otherwise the speaker may conclude that what they are talking about is uninteresting to the listener.



Interest can be conveyed to the speaker by using both verbal and non-verbal messages such as maintaining eye contact, nodding your head and smiling, agreeing by saying 'Yes' or simply 'Mmm hmm' to encourage them to continue. By providing this 'feedback' the person speaking will usually feel more at ease and therefore communicate more easily, openly and honestly.

Listening is the most fundamental component of interpersonal communication skills.

Listening is not something that just happens (that is hearing), listening is an active process in which a conscious decision is made to listen to and understand the messages of the speaker.

Listeners should remain neutral and non-judgmental, this means trying not to take sides or form opinions, especially early in the conversation. Active listening is also about patience - pauses and short periods of silence should be accepted.

Listeners should not be tempted to jump in with questions or comments every time there are a few seconds of silence. Active listening involves giving the other person time to explore their thoughts and feelings, they should, therefore, be given adequate time for that.

Active listening not only means focusing fully on the speaker but also actively showing verbal and non-verbal signs of listening. All this was learnt by the students via a Role play activity which involved students to form groups and to ask 2 questions to each other. All this while the facilitator, Prof. JahanAara Pathan was adding some loud music sounds in the background to create disturbance.

Initially the students were disturbed and lost the focus. However, later they adapted to the surroundings and communicated better way this time; as they learnt to 'Listen' than just 'Hear'.

It was a grand successful activity as to students could learn the objective of this activity.




A Report on Communication Skills Workshop -
