Report on "Quantitative Aptitude"

Quantitative aptitude shows one's ability to comprehend and solve problems. As the tests are time bound, they also test the logical thinking of the candidates and their ability to reason and make effective decisions quickly under pressure. Reasoning is one ability that is unique to human beings.

In most of the exam, quantitative aptitude test is conducted as a part of the written exam, which is usually the very first round of the selection procedure.Quantitative Aptitude test basically involves mathematical questions. In these questions, speed of the candidate matters more than his/her knowledge and this needs quantitative aptitude tricks. Quantitative Aptitude paper is an essential part of almost all competitive exams.

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
Report of Guest Lecture on Career in Banking






Figure 2 The HR Team of TCS giving their presentation(12/12/2017)

Objective:- The main objective of Mega pool Campus Drive 2017 was to facilitate the




