Programme Report

The college library subscribes to prominent National and International journals, local newspapers, and magazines. Moreover, the library has subscribed to N-LIST consortia where more than 6000+ e-journals and 3135000+ e-books are freely accessible to students and teachers.

About the FDP:

The teaching and learning process in our country as well as abroad is transforming due to the advent of Information and Communication technology (ICT). Virtual/Online classrooms have become a digital replica of traditional classrooms where participants learn in real-time, face-to-face environment via the internet-enabled technology devices. The development of Electronic content (E-content) and its dissemination through digital Audio/Video/animation techniques have gained prominence due to this virtualization in the educational field. The UGC, AICTE and HRD Ministry have already undertaken significant steps in this direction by setting up portals such as SWAYAM, NPTEL and MOOC platforms under the National Mission on Education through ICT (NME-ICT) programme. In view of this it has now become obligatory for teachers to acquire necessary technical skills and adopt use of ICT on a massive scale. The expenditure to set up a studio needs heavy investment beyond the reach of a common teacher. The aim of this FDP is to familiarize the teaching faculty with newer techniques which are commonly accessible and affordable with minimum investments.

This was an Exclusive FDP which was organized for the faculty members of Poona College of Arts Science and Commerce. A total of 22 Faculty Members including Principal - Dr. Aftab Anwar Shaikh, Advisor - Dr. M.Rafiq Sarakhwas and Vice-Principal Mr. Iqbal Shaikh attended the FDP.

Dr. Sharon Barnhardt, Director, CESS Nuffield – FLAME University and Ex-Faculty member of IIM Ahmedabad gave the welcome address. Dr. Pavan Mamidi, Co- Director of CESS Nuffield – FLAME University and Ex-Faculty of IIM Bangalore, University of Michigan Law School & Harvard Law School introduced the Speaker Dr. B. Shekar who is a retired professor from *IIM Bangalore*.

Dr. Shekar is featured in the 2013 edition of '2000 Outstanding Intellectuals of the 21st Century', published by the International Biographical Society, Cambridge, UK. In his first Session Dr. B.Shekar Spoke on Inquiry Specific Perceptual Learning and emphasized on the importance of the same. He said that the faculty members must entice the students to ask questions thereby initiating a thinking cycle in the young minds. He used a unique methodology of teaching-learning, vis-à-vis use of movies and songs in explaining the concept of perceptual learning. In his second session Dr. B.Shekar Spoke about perceptions, foreground, background and the importance of Silence.

The Important upshots from his Sessions were as follows:

- 1) Faculty Members need to improve their involvement with the students
- 2) We must love what we do (Teaching)
- 3) Evoke Inquiry Centric Perceptual Learning in students
- 4) Promote perceptual Learning in students
- 5) Every teacher needs to be an actor.

Principal Dr. Aftab Anwar Shaikh took the onus and personally proposed the vote of thanks. The FDP Concluded with a campus tour of the Flame University.

Objectives of Quality Seminar on "Academic Audit":-

- 4) To provide valuable suggestions to boost the confidence of the faculty to achieve remarkable academic standards in the competitive educational environment.

Report :-

The IQAC, AKIs Poona College of Arts, Science & Commerce, Pune organized a two day quality seminar on Academic Audit on 8th and 9th December 2018 at Poona College Conference Hall. The seminar began with Tilawat a Quran recited by Mr. Musharrif Hussain. Post recitation of Quranic Verses, Mr. Iqbal Shaikh, Vice Principal –Science & Coordinator-IQAC concisely articulated the objectives of the seminar. He stated that this seminar would be categorically focus on the academic processes and achievements in terms of curricular, co-curricular, extra-curricular activities in the first term of 2018-19 of various departments.
