

- 2. Maximum time limit for each speaker will be 7 minutes a warning bell will be given before one minute of the limited time.
- 3. The speakers will not be permitted to refer any prepared speech, written notes or scripts.
- 4. The trophy will be handed over the teacher incharge of the winning college team which must be returned by the winning college two months before the competition for the new academic year at its own expenses.
- 5. The winning college must take care of the trophy/ shield and will be responsible for any damage to it.
- 6. The entry fees will be Rs. 200/- in cash for each participating team which shall be collected at the time of competition.
- 7. The decision of the judges in all the matters of the completion shall be final and absolute.
- 8. Interested colleges should register their entries on or before 27/01/17 on the college letter head duly signed by the principal/ incharge only.


