



REPORT ON TWO-DAY WORKSHOP ON RESEARCH METHODOLOGY

A two-day workshop on research methodology was held on 20th January 2024 and 23th February 2024 at Poona College Conference Hall and Commerce tally lab respectively. The workshop aimed to introduce participants to various concepts related to research, such as research types, hypothesis testing, and research design. **Total 58 students** were present for this two days' workshop.

On the first day of exploration into the theme of Project Guidance. Dr.Shailendra Kale has highlighted the various aspect of Research Methodology, The focus was primarily on understanding the foundational aspects that contribute to successful project guidance. The day commenced with an in-depth literature review, aiming to identify key principles, methodologies, and best practices relevant to guiding research projects effectively.

The morning session involved discussions on the role of a mentor in shaping research projects, emphasizing the importance of clear communication, goal-setting, and fostering a supportive environment. This set the tone for the rest of the day, where students delved into various research methodologies commonly employed in project guidance, considering both qualitative and quantitative approaches.

Professor (Dr.) Aftab Anwar Shaikh has highlighted the role of Practical case studies and presented to illustrate how different methodologies were applied in real-world project guidance scenarios. The day concluded with an engaging workshop, providing hands-on experience in developing effective research questions and hypotheses, setting the stage for the practical application of the knowledge gained.

Day 2: Practical Implementation and Ethical Considerations

Dr. Hamed Hashmi has emphasized on literature review and conducted hand on training on how to conduct extensive literature review. A report on Entrepreneurship Development Program (EDP)

Introduction

- Post-Program Support: Implementing a follow-up program or alumni network could help maintain momentum and provide ongoing support to participants.

The Entrepreneurship Development Program successfully achieved its objectives, fostering a supportive environment for aspiring entrepreneurs. By equipping participants with essential skills and resources, the program contributed to individual growth and potential economic impact. Continued investment in such initiatives is crucial for nurturing the entrepreneurial spirit and driving innovation in the community. With the implementation of the outlined recommendations, future EDPs can be even more impactful, ensuring a sustainable pipeline of new ventures and economic development.




